

Science

This term, children will study the unit plants. They will learn how to identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants, explore the requirements of plants for life and growth. In the second half term, children will be studying light.

They will learn how to recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. Children will learn how to recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.

Geography

Children are researching biomes with a focus on Amazon Rainforest. They will be able to state the location and some key features of the Amazon, including naming and describing the four layers of tropical rainforests.

History

This term, children will study Prehistoric Britain. They will learn about which animals lived during this time and what happened to them. Also, children will learn about The Stone Age and how it is split into three different periods. They will learn the names of these different periods and what developments humans made during each of them.

Art

Pupils will learn how to draw using tone to create 3D effect, explore how combining lines and mark making can create texture and tone, understand how to use proportion in art work by looking at how artists use it and will create an effective composition before applying all these skills to their own drawing.

Music

In Music, children will create a composition in response to an animation. Year 4 will also be participating in the Hexagon Music Festival again this year.

PE

Children will be able to implement the basic rules of football and show control skills. Children will develop their accuracy with maintaining possession and building attacking play.

DT

Children are learning how to safely cut a variety of fruits to make different seasonal dishes. They will learn how to make fruit kebabs, a fruit crumble and fruit tarts.

PSHE

Children will be exploring relationships including how to be appreciative, having rights and responsibilities along with making choices. Children will also learn about body changes and how to manage feelings.

Computing

Children are learning the concepts of networks, learning how devices communicate. They will identify and learn how information is shared by exploring real world networks.
